The Forum have been progressing NEG project work throughout 2024, and we look forward to updating you at the next on-line NEG meeting scheduled for 20th November 2024.

### **NEG Funded Projects**

Each year NEG provides up to £4,000 in awards to projects that seek to improve environmental outcomes in the Solent.

Projects Funded for 2024/25:

- Exploring and recording the underwater habitats of Langstone and Chichester Harbours (Portunus)
- When is a wading bird not a wading bird? The case of the European Starling (UoP)

Updates will be provided at the next NEG meeting.

### **NEG Meeting**

The next NEG meeting will be held on **20th November 2024**, an agenda and paper will be sent out in October.

The agenda this year will include an update on Solent Marine Sites actions for NEG; an update on NEG funded projects; an update on the Solent Seascape Project: Recovery workstream; and presentations on several subjects.

#### **SEMS Actions to NEG**

We have been working on the SEMS actions set for NEG in 2023; a full report will be presented at the NEG November 2024 meeting. Ongoing work is as follows:

- Solent Forum (NEG Secretariat) continues to chair the Solent Recovery working group which is producing the Solent Recovery Plan and a data portal to map pressures and habitats.
- Littering and especially plastics <u>Clean Solent Shores and Seas (CSSS)</u> continues to signpost resources on littering and many other water quality issues.
- NEG has been monitoring the <u>Catchwise project</u> outcomes. The project will report early in 2025.
- The impacts and management options for paddlesports in the Solent (IMP). Chichester
  Harbour Conservancy are piloting a 2-year survey methodology, and provided year 1
  results for NEG see <u>presentation</u> on NEG website. Year two results are expected shortly.
